Hi Mike,

I just wanted to follow up with the intentions as discussed in our phone conversation today. The mental health walk signs will consist of 8 aluminum signs painted with black rustolium paint, edges sanded smooth, and Oracle 651 white vinyl. This vinyl has a 6 year outdoor rating. The signs will be placed where instructed by maintenance with the help of Ryan Wilson. Ryan is a landscaper with hardscaping experience who is donating his time to help the girls and teach them how to dig the posts and install the signs to ensure they are plum. It will be determined upon install as to what is needed to ensure they are stable wither it be cement or fence post foam. If the project needs repairs or maintenance in the future please contact myself first (330)360-4232 if I am not around contact gsneo.org and leave a message for customer care. GSNEO will reach out to other local troops and ask them to fix.

The completion deadline is September 30, 2024. If the project is not completed before then the girls will not earn their Silver Award. The Silver Award is the second highest award a Girl Scout can earn. To accomplish this award they must complete a Journey (This is a 8-10 hour process in badgework) as well as a Take Action Project. The girls helped make almost 100 dog toys and donated to the Trumbull Co Pound. After that is complete they spend 50 hours each planning, and carrying out their project, these hours have been made up in the planning, research and construction as well as install of the signs. The remaining hours are contributed to the planning of the unveiling ceremony as well as set up, and clean up.

Project: Mental Health walk installed along the Bazetta Township walking trail at the Bazetta Township Park.

- Signs made by Shane as referred by Andrea. Shane's boss donated the materials and Shane made them free of charge. Donated boxes of cookies to Shane and his boss as a thank you.
- Signs to be pained and vinyl installed on signs
- Install signs at park per where the Park Maintenance department marks out.
- Unveiling ceremony. September 22, 2-4pm
 - Invite community, and community politicians, newspaper, tv to see the walk and talk with the girls about their work
 - Tables available for local mental health providers to distribute information and how to get help
 - Currently have 4 providers as well as other interested parties who provide medical or self care services.
 - Clean up after event.
 - The purpose of this event is to draw attention to the walk and the girls hard work. Having the mental health providers helps spread awareness to mental health

diseases, normalize getting help, and allows community members to find help that they may need. Inviting the politicians helps show those who serve us how the Girl Scouts are also working on serving the community.

The girls will be at the September 10th Trustee caucus at 6pm. If they can please discuss with the trustees the project and intention first as Belle is scheduled to be in Vienna for a Service Unit Meeting to run for Membership Delegate, which is the local representative of the local troops who reports to council and serves as a voting member below the board.
